There are three trips I am informing you about, with the opportunity for your child/children to show an initial expression of interest.

Students must register their interest before school or afterschool with the linked member of staff by no later than Wednesday 28 November. Details of the trips and the linked member of staff are outlined below. Performing Arts do Hollywood - 7 days and 5 nights

Saturday 19 October - Friday 25 October 2019

Open to all current Year 7-10 students. Flying London to Los Angeles, having 5 nights stay with breakfast and dinner included. Seeing the sights of Hollywood's Walk of Fame, Grauman's Chinese Theatre, Warner Bros Studio tour, Dolby Theatre Tour, Acting for Film Workshop, Acting for Camera experience and filming your own commercial and amazing memories of all that is the glitz of Rodeo Drive and the show biz capital of the world!

Estimated cost of the trip is £1800 (dependent on flights at time of booking and sufficient numbers) includes flights, accommodation, breakfast and dinners (lunches and tipping not included).

History give the real Berlin Experience

Friday 25 October 2019 - Monday 28 October 2019

This trip is being offered to our current Year 10 students studying GCSE History as a first priority, however other students will also be able to apply. During this trip, students will have the opportunity to understand more clearly their History syllabus and exam topics of *Weimar and Nazi Germany* and *Superpowers and The Cold War*. Visiting the Reichstag, Hitler's Bunker, Cold War Bunkers, Jewish Museum, Topography of Terror Museum. Evening activities will include The TV Tower, bowling and evening walks.

Estimated cost of the trip is £595, includes flights, accommodation and all meals.

Geography escape to The Azores
