


Below are the instructions to guide you through the registration process and create a STARTPROFILE for your child. This is a fantastic resource for young people and parents to use with regards to careers and qualifications.

Step 1:




Head to the home screen of STARTPROFILE and click on the register tab.

How we use your data

Start collects data from users to personalise their experience and to help make sense of the vast amount of careers information available. Using this data, Start helps users to make more informed choices around future study and career options. This information is stored securely in a user's own password protected area.

If your child uses Start at school or college, their teachers and careers guidance professionals will have access to information collected on their activity. This information will be used to support students on their journey through education and into employment.



Step 6: We have asked your child to complete the 'About me' activities which will help them build a profile of interested and help direct them to jobs, courses and careers that match their skills.

Click on my interests and it takes them to a page where they rate the different hobbies or activities.

Work preferences help them identify what types of jobs they may want

Skills helps them identify skills

Qualities helps them understand their personable qualities.



The quizzes and activities they complete will be saved in their locker so they can go back to them, save things for later and map their progress over the 5 years.

Tasks will be set in PSHE lessons for them to add things to their locker along with designing an action plan.

Any work or volunteering or things they do out of school should be logged here too.

CVs and covering letters can be uploaded and saved to their locker.

Now they just have to work out what they want to do!
