Dear Parents/Guardians

Re: Year 10 Core Assessments

Please be advised that the Year 10 Core Assessments begin on Monday 14 June until Tuesday 22 June inclusive in the Sports Hall. A copy of the assessment timetable is detailed below, will be placed on our website and a hard copy will be given to students.

The assessments will test the students on aspects of the work covered since the start of Year 10. Students will be given advice about how to prepare via their subject teachers. It is important that students gradually build up their experience of taking examinations within a formal setting.

We are unable to rearrange any assessments which are missed, so we would ask that you make every effort to ensure your child attends school during this time.

End of year assessments for all other subjects will occur in the weeks after the half term and up to Friday 2 July but within lesson time, so that we can provide a report on your child's progress up to the end of the academic year. This will include English Literature, which will be assessed separately with an essay completed in class on 'An Inspector Calls' (the text being studied at the time).

Where students have agreed access arrangements or reasonable adjustments (for example a reader or a scribe) we will make every effort to ensure that these arrangements are in place when assessments are being taken. Where an assessment takes place without an agreed reasonable adjustment or access arrangements, this will be noted and considered when determining performance.

Each department has been asked to provide details on what and how to revise before half term for assessments. In addition, this will be posted via Team and EduLink. Further advice will be given about how to approach and plan revision via assemblies and any resources added to the Exams section of our website.

The assessments are very important and I ask you to ensure that your child uses the time between now and Monday 14 June to revise thoroughly. Students will also be guided as to the arrangements and expectations for the assessments via assemblies after half term.
