School Uniform – continued

- **Jewellery** – Up to two small stud per ear lobe is the only jewellery allowed. Piercings in other places are not permitted, for example, nose, tongue, stretcher or eyebrow stud. No exceptions will be made for a “new” piercing. No diamanté style jewellery or bracelets, rings or necklaces should be worn.
- **Make up** – should not be worn in Years 7-8; in Years 9-11 it may be worn with discretion; however, false eyelashes are not allowed. No acrylic, gel or false nails of any description; coloured nail varnish is not permitted.
- **Hair** – should be of an acceptable style, natural in colour and must be tied back for all practical lessons. Boys should be clean-shaven, and hair must be a minimum cut of grade 2, tramlines are not allowed.
- **Hoodies** – must not be worn on the school site and will be confiscated for the day.
- **Belts** – plain black or brown with a standard buckle.
- **Coats** – should be dark in colour with no patterns. Coats should not be worn in the classrooms.
- **School bag** – should be able to take an A4 size book/folder/file and be dark in colour with no offensive design or logo.

- **Chewing Gum** – is not permitted anywhere on the school grounds.
- **Mobile phones** – should only be used at break/lunch times in the Blue Diner or in designated areas. Speakers are not permitted anywhere on the school premises.
- **Ear/Headphones** – are not permitted **at any time** during school hours and will be confiscated.

Confiscated items can be collected from Reception at the end of the school day.

The school tries to ensure the safety of all personal property, however, **it cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage**, and this includes mobile phones and other electronic items.

If in doubt about any of these points, please contact the school for clarification.
