## **Examination Results**

### **2016/2017**

#### **Key Stage 4 – GCSE/BTEC Headlines**

- 70% of students achieved a 9-4 in English and Maths
- 62% achieved 5+ A\*-C including English and Maths
- 6.4% of entries were A\*
- 66.2% of entries were A\*-C
- 77% 9-4 in English Language of English Literature
- 78% 9-4 in Maths
- 32% of students achieved the Ebacc
- 61% of students made expected progress or better in English
- 70% of students made expected progress or better in Maths

Head Teacher Mike Boddington said “We are really pleased with these results that come in a time of considerable uncertainty across the country. Our students and staff have worked really hard and this is evident in the outcomes that they have achieved. The skills and knowledge that our students have gained throughout their time here are invaluable and we continue to raise our standards across all aspects of school life.
