# Esher Church of England High School Examination Results <br> 2015/2016 

## Key Stage 4 - GCSE/BTEC Headlines

- $69 \%$ of students achieved an $\mathrm{A}^{*}-\mathrm{C}$ in English and Maths
- $62 \%$ of students achieved $5+$ A $^{*}$ - C including English and Maths ( $12 \%$ increase on 2015)
- $7.4 \%$ of entries were A* (national 6.4\%)
- $68.1 \%$ of entries were $\mathrm{A}^{*}-\mathrm{C}$ (national $66.9 \%$ )
- $78 \% \mathrm{~A}^{*}$-C in Maths ( $17 \%$ above the National Average)
- $75 \%$ A*-C in English or English Literature
- $34 \%$ of students achieved the EBacc ( $32 \%$ in 2015)
- $75 \%$ of students made expected progress or better in English
- $\quad 75 \%$ of students made expected progress or better in Maths
- 15 students received 9 or more A* - A grades
- Progress 8 Score - 0.22
- Attainment 8 Score - 50.0

Head teacher Mike Boddington is delighted "These results tell such a story. This cohort of students' attainment scores when they started with us in Year 7 were within 2\% of the national average. Five years later they have achieved significantly better than the national average not only at $A^{*}-C$, but at the $A^{*}$ level as well".
