



CODE OF CONDUCT ON BUSES AND COACHES FOR STUDENTS

This code of conduct has been produced in partnership between Esher C of E High School and the Safer Travel partnership to ensure that all students, as passengers, are aware of the importance of good behaviour on bus networks and any school chartered coaches. This contract is in place to guarantee both the safety of students, bus staff and other passengers and to ensure that vehicles are treated with respect at all times journeying to and from school and on school visits.

ALL STUDENTS MUST:

- pay the correct fare or show their Travel Card to the driver, where appropriate
- act in an orderly manner at all times whilst waiting for and travelling on the bus/coach
- not move around the bus/coach and stay seated whilst the bus/coach is in motion
- show respect towards the driver and fellow passengers
- take responsibility for reporting any anti-social behaviour to the school, police or the bus / coach operators

STUDENTS MUST NOT:

- smoke (a maximum fine of £1,000 may be imposed by bus/coach companies)
 - use bad language, verbal or physical abuse towards fellow passengers or bus/coach drivers / inspectors whilst using bus/coach services
 - cause criminal damage or write graffiti anywhere on vehicles
 - tamper with emergency exits or throw objects from the bus/coach windows
 - distract the bus/coach driver
 - tamper with any CCTV equipment inside the bus/coach. This is a criminal offence
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I UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS LAID OUT IN THE CONTRACT ABOVE AND AGREE TO UPHOLD THIS CONTRACT. I UNDERSTAND THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONDITIONS OF THIS CONTRACT MAY RESULT IN A BANNING ORDER FROM BUS/COACH SERVICES AND IN CERTAIN INSTANCES MAY RESULT IN PROSECUTION.
