Welcome to Esher High School! We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of our Esher High School Induction Day on **Tuesday 28 June 2022**. On this day, «Forename» will visit the school and have a busy day getting a feel for their new school.

You will be able to drop «Forename» off between **8.15am – 8.30am**. We will have overflow parking available, please follow the signs. Children are to wear the uniform of their current primary school (no leaver's hoodies please) and should bring a school bag and pencil case. Students will also need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle, refreshments will be provided by the school at morning break. Students entitled to Free School Meals will be provided with a packed lunch if requested [here](#). The day will end at **3.30pm**.

Please note when collecting your child at the end of day there will be no access for cars to drive on to the school site before 3.30pm. From 3.30pm, parents will be able to collect students from the front of school where your child will be waiting for you. However, if you give your child permission to walk home directly from EHS at 3.30pm this must be indicated [here](#).

The Parents Induction Evening will also take place on Tuesday 28 June, where you will have the opportunity to meet the Headteacher and Head of Year 7. There will be two talks in the Performing Arts Centre.

The first talk at **6.30pm** will be for parents of students that surname's begin with **A – L**. The second talk will commence at **7.15pm** for parents of students that surname's begin with **M - Z**. On arrival please follow the one-way Event Parking signs.

There will be two Year 7 Virtual Welcome Evenings. The first will be 'Meet the Head of School', Mr King & Head of Year, Mr Powley. This will take place on Tuesday 14 June from 5 – 6pm. The second will be 'Meet the Student Wellbeing Co-ordinator', Mrs Smurthwaite and a Q & A session for students. This will take place on Tuesday 21 June from 5 – 6pm, a link will be sent out nearer the time for both sessions.

There is also a two-day Summer School running on the 30 and 31 August. This is free for students and a great chance to have some fun and get to know other Year 7 students. Our Year 7'S last year found this to be a real highlight of joining us.

Please note the first day for Year 7 students is **Thursday 1 September 2022**, starting at 8.45am.
