



Uniform Guidelines for Footwear

We take pride in our students' appearance, and hope that they do too. By wearing full school uniform which includes the shoes they wear, it helps maintain our high standards and reduces the opportunity for visible branding that can undermine the essence of student uniform. All students are therefore expected to wear shoes that comply with our uniform guidelines.

To help you ensure that your child's school shoes are acceptable within our uniform guidelines, please see the table below.

Option A: Polishable **low** heeled black **shoes** (no branding, no trainers, boots, platforms or sling-backs)

Option B: Polishable low heeled black **shoes** (no branding, no trainers or boots)

	Smart leather/leather alternative shoe. Plain black.		
	No buckles or studs. No skate shoes or trainers. No Hi-tops or plimsoles. No canvas or fabric shoes. No stripes or logos.		

Shoes should be plain black, polishable, flat soled or with a small heel and have no trim or branding so no logos - even a black Nike tick, or Vans logo is not acceptable. Contrast coloured laces and trainer or casual styles are not permitted. Please be aware, 'Vans' lace ups are not appropriate, including the leather look version – see table below:
