Dear Families,

We have had an exciting few weeks in school showcasing our community to prospective parents. The feedback we have had about their visits, but also the lovely recommendations you have given, have been heartwarming. Thank you for your support, it makes our job that bit easier!

With one more week until half term break, I am sure we will be coming back to some cooler weather after the holiday. A reminder of some key areas on uniform and staying warm to make the return as smooth as possible:

- Coats are encouraged, these are to be worn over school uniform (including blazers). Coats will need to be removed before going into lessons.
- In school uniform, jumpers are optional, blazers are a daily requirement.
- Students can wear their school PE mid layer, v neck knitted school jumper or blazer with PE kit to keep warm. A coat over their polo is allowed.
- PE jogger bottoms or plain black jogger bottoms to be worn with PE kit.
- Hoodies are not permitted.
