Blazer	Black blazer with badge**

Shoes	Polishable low heeled black shoes (see school website for shoes that are acceptable)
Jumper	Black v neck knit jumper with or without logo (optional)

### Option A

Skirt	EHS Tartan skirt worn on the knee **
Trousers	Black Trutex boot cut trousers (optional)
Blouse	Plain white reverse collar school blouse
Tights	Black or flesh coloured plain tights
Socks	Black, grey or white socks (crew length)

### Option B

Trousers	Plain black tailored trousers
School Tie	Years 7, 8 + 9 - Red stripe ** Years 10 + 11 - Blue stripe **
Shirt	White collared shirt
Socks	Black or grey

## PE Uniform

- PE jumpers are either a plain black v neck school jumper or the EHS PE jumper/mid layer. **Please note that branded Nike/Adidas mid layers or jumpers are not permitted.**
- PE shorts/skorts are to be either plain black or EHS PE items (no cycling shorts).
- PE leggings are to be either plain black leggings or EHS leggings.
- PE jogger bottoms are to be either EHS bottoms or plain black bottoms. No stripes or coloured inserts.
- If choosing plain black shorts, joggers, tracksuits skirts or leggings, brand logos must not be bigger than the size of a small post-it note.

## Other

- **Jewellery** - up to two small studs per ear lobe and one small nose stud is the only jewellery allowed. Piercings in other places are not permitted, for example, tongue, stretcher or eyebrow stud. One of each of the following will be permitted; bracelet, ring and necklace.
- **Make up** - should not be worn in Years 7 + 8; in Years 9, 10 + 11 it may be worn with discretion; however, false eyelashes are not allowed. No acrylic, gel or false nails of any description.
- **Hair** - should be of an acceptable style, natural in colour and must be tied back for all practical lessons, tramlines are not allowed.
- **Hoodies** - must not be worn on the school site and will be confiscated for the day.
- **Belts** - plain black or brown with a standard buckle.
- **Coats** - should be for outdoor use, no denim. Coats should only be worn outside classrooms.
- **School bag** - should be able to take an A4 size book/folder/file and with no offensive design or logo.
- **Chewing Gum** - is not permitted anywhere on the school grounds.
- **Energy Drinks** - are not permitted in school.
- **Mobile phones** - Students are not permitted to have their phones visible during the school day, unless given permission by the teacher. Speakers are not permitted anywhere on the school premises.
- **Ear/Headphones** - are not permitted *at any time* during school hours and will be confiscated.

Confiscated items can be collected from Reception at the end of the school day.

The school tries to ensure the safety of all personal property, however, **it cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage**, this includes mobile phones and other electronic items. If in doubt about any of these points, please contact the school for clarification.
