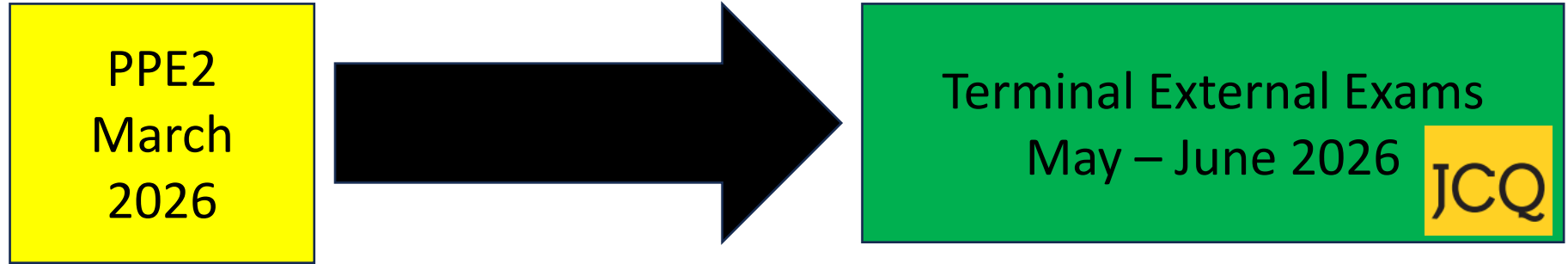

# Why Have PPEs?

- PPEs help get you used to the JCQ exam procedures that we will follow in the Summer.

# Daily Schedule – AM

## P1 & P2:

- Register with your tutor at 8.45am.
- After you have registered at 8.50am: you will go to the tennis courts to line up.
- At the end of the exam the lead invigilator will instruct you whether to return to lesson or (if the exam finishes close to break time) to the blue diner

## P3:

- **Normal lessons.**
- Teachers **may** let you revise during this time – if so it must be purposeful
- You must have all your revision materials in class with you (**you will not be allowed to leave class to collect revision materials from other teachers**)

# Daily Schedule – PM

## Early Lunch

# Be Prepared!

- 1. Wear the correct school uniform:** Normal expectations apply, uniform will be checked on entry.
- 2. Know your seat before going into the exams:**
  - Shared by Tutors during registration.
  - Displayed on notice board on the tennis courts.
  - Displayed notice board next to the boys toilets in the auditorium.
  - Emailed to you in your timetable.
- 3. Store your belongings safely:** **Mobile phones and watches are not allowed in the exam room.** Store these safely elsewhere. If you enter the room with a mobile phone or watch, notify the invigilator and they will collect and the normal school rules will apply.
- 4. Bring your equipment in a clear pencil case:** 2 x black pens, highlighter, 30cm ruler, calculator, pencil, rubber.
- 5. Bring a bottle of water:** clear bottles only, labels must be removed

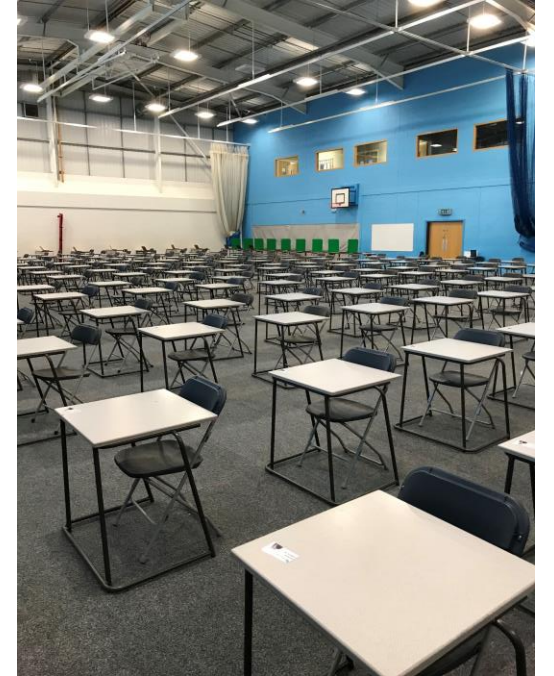
# Items prohibited from exam hall

- **No** mobile phones
- **No** ear buds and headphones
- **No** MP3/MP4 players
- **No** writing on your hand (including seat numbers)
- **No watches**
- Clear water bottles only – no labels
- Clear pencil cases only
- **Remove the lids from calculators**



# Conduct During Assessments

1. Enter the Exam Room in silence – do not communicate with any other candidate in any way.
2. Go straight to your seat – check you are in the right place by reading the candidate card
3. Check you have the correct paper.
4. **DO NOT write on or open the paper** until you are told to do so by the invigilator.
5. **DO NOT doodle on your exam paper unless you have it as a specific access arrangement.** If you doodle this it may not be marked.
6. **DO NOT leave the sports hall until the end of the exam**
7. If you have any queries or feel unwell raise your hand to speak to a member of staff.
8. Only pack up when you have been dismissed by the invigilator
