Drone Pilot

A drone pilot (UAV operator) remotely flies unmanned aircraft for commercial services like aerial photography, surveying, and inspections. They work in varied industries, often as freelancers, and must possess CAA training and certifications. Professional pilots plan flights, monitor equipment, and manage safety.

The most popular areas for Degree Apprenticeship industries are health (27.5%), construction (22.3%) and digital technology (16.9%). Regional take-up of degree apprenticeships varies, with London (19.1%) and the North West (15.1) topping the table, while the North East (3.0%) seeing lowest take-up. Source

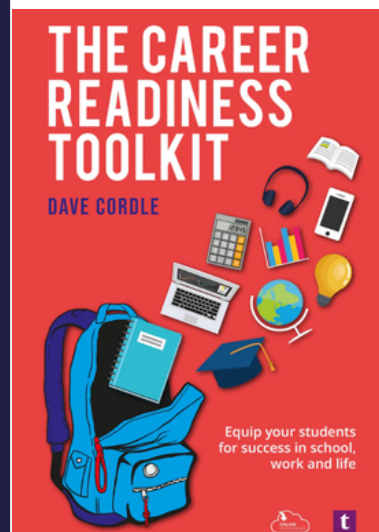
